Pupil Premium Eligibility

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding. By applying for Free School Meals (whether your child decides to have them or not), our academy receives additional funding in the form of Pupil Premium. This is an invaluable source of income to our academy in times when budgets are being drastically reduced.

Last year, our Pupil Premium funding meant that we could employ additional adults to support children's learning and social/emotional needs.

If you are in receipt of one of the following benefits, please complete the slip below and ask your child to return to SID (Student Information Desk) and we will support you with your application:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
