Results Day

Year 11 GCSE Results Day is on **Thursday 24th August 2023**. Students can come to Main Reception between **9am - 11am** on this day to collect their results from the Dining Room. We look forward to seeing lots of happy smiling faces on the day with students being proud of their dedication and hard work. If any students would like support regarding their next steps information about support from Progress Careers will be available on the day.

What if the student cannot come in to collect their results on the 24th August?

If a student cannot make the results collection there are alternatives to receiving results:

- A student can allocate a person to collect on their behalf. To do this, the student must inform us of who this person will be - before the 24th August and that person must arrive with photo identification to prove who they are.
- A student can leave with us before we break up for the summer holidays, a stamped self addressed envelope, we will put their results slip in the envelope and post this to the student.

Review of results

If you feel when reviewing the grade boundary that you would like the external marking of your paper to be reviewed (previously known as a remark) then please contact the enquiries email and we will get back to you in September to discuss this further, please note that there is a cost to this and that the grade can go down as well as up or stay the same. If we feel that a review of your paper is required we will contact you.

Certificate collection

Please note that on this day students will only receive a 'Statement of Results'. This is an overview of what grades a student has been awarded. Actual certificates do not arrive in the academy until the Autumn Term. We will let you know when these are available. Students must collect these - this

is vital! This is the evidence of results which future education and employment providers will need to see. If these are not collected within 6 years after the results we have to return these to the exam board and it is then down to the individual to apply for them again, at a very high cost. If you know of family and friends who have over the previous years not collected their certificates, please encourage them to come to Main Reception with photo ID during the academy opening hours as soon as possible.

Uniform

Please remember that we have a green recycle bin outside of main reception. If you have any good quality clothing please put it in this bin. Ties especially are required for students to loan on a daily basis.
