We will be making a further commitment to plastic recycling. There is currently a bin for empty plastic bottles in the dining room and did you know that each of our academy blazers uses 31 plastic bottles in its manufacture? This results in Trutex saving over 9 million bottles from landfill every year.





Recycling batteries has been a successful strategy with the bin installed in main reception. If you need a place to recycle yours please drop them in.

Our wildlife garden in the main building quad is coming on beautifully. We currently have growing a variety of

vegetables and flowers and because of this we are getting more wildlife now than ever. The students' self built birdhouses and wind chimes look amazing. Thank you to all students and staff who have supported this.


