2. How we use your data:

The Music Service needs to collect the following information about you and your child. The Music Service has obtained your personal data from you and your child's school in order to provide their service:

Name and address of student and their parent/carer (including looked after children), student's date of birth, school and any relevant Special Educational Needs/learning difficulties.

We use this information to contact you regarding tuition, instrument loans, assessment and reports, exam information and to keep you informed of any other musical opportunities that Wakefield Music Education Hub may have to offer. *To enable us to provide our service to you, we will only share relevant information with your child's school and Instrumental teacher*. Should you decide not to provide any of the information we request from you, we may be unable to provide your child with instrumental/ensemble tuition.

3. What authority does the Council have to collect and use this information?

4. How long will we keep your data?

We will keep your personal information collected for the purpose(s) detailed in section 2 for a period of 7 years after which time it will be deleted from our systems. The reason for keeping information for this period of time is to comply with government regulations regarding data.

5. Your rights and your personal data
